Dear Singers,

I'm excited to present to you the first opportunity for a **#ypccroadtrip!** YPCC is filled with motivated, talented singers, and it's high time to showcase your awesome-ness to the world.

**On May 25 2019**, YPCC has been invited to serve as the core of nationally recruited choir in a performance at Carnegie Hall. Both conductors on this program hail from Cincinnati, both are **#badassartsmamas** and both have ties to YPCC – Dr. Eva Floyd, PhD (CCM Music Education Choral Chair) and KellyAnn Nelson, Founder & Artistic Director of YPCC.

The repertoire for this opportunity will be Morten Lauridsen's "Lux Aeterna" and William Menefield's commissioned choral work, written for YPCC, called "PRISM". This rep will first be performed on **Tuesday May 21, 2019 at the newly-opened Cincinnati Museum Center's Union Terminal** as the final concert for next year's YPCC spring concert, so there will be no additional rehearsals required. Singers over the age of 45 and other local choir members will be welcomed to join us for next year's spring cycle and the **May 22-26 trip to NYC** (in an effort to keep costs as low as possible). Collegium Cincinnati's annual SummerSing will feature Faure's Requiem and Lauridsen's Lux Aeterna this summer – **July 22-28, 2018** for any singers who are interested in an additional opportunity to learn the work. **Mike Crandall**, former YPCC singer/board member, will manage our trip through Bob Rogers Travel. Mid-America Productions is the producer of the **Carnegie Hall rehearsals and concert**, and it costs a minimum of \$900 just to perform the work. Mike has added **4 nights of a prime mid-town hotel, tickets to a top-tier Broadway show, a great group dinner, a post-concert dinner cruise or reception**, in addition to an online portal for payments, access to Travel Insurance and more for between an additional \$739 – \$1,789 more. Your payments will be broken up between May 2018 and April 2019. Please note – none of these packages include airfare or travel to and from NYC, so you are welcome to use a bus, ride a horse, take the train, use your own airline miles, stay late, arrive early (but don't miss the May 21 spring concert!), or more. You will have one night completely free to explore the city in your own way with your choir family or your own NYC people.

Costs are based on **30 travelers** – if we recruit more, it will cost less – so help us spread the word to interested singers far and wide. Your costs are based on how you share your hotel room – so if you choose quad occupancy, you need to know who your roommates will be in advance. There is a non-singer price as well, in case your spouse/partner/friend/goldfish would like to join. They will have access to everything (including the concert) with the exception of watching you rehearse.

Read the attached information and register for an IPS account no later than **May 15**. And then let's "start spreading the news..." ☺ See you in the Big Apple next Memorial Day weekend!

## GENERAL LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

**Insurance benefits are not payable for any loss due to, arising or resulting from:** 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You, while sane or insane; 2. an act of declared or undeclared war; 3. participating in maneuvers or training exercises of an armed service, except while participating in weekend or summer training for the reserve forces of the United States, including the National Guard; 4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events; 5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment); 6. participating as a member of a team in an organized sporting competition; 7. participating in bodily contact sports, skydiving or parachuting, hang gliding or bungee cord jumping; 8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft; 9. being intoxicated, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician; 10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation; 11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion; 12. dental treatment (except as coverage is otherwise specifically provided); 13. amounts which exceed the Maximum Benefit Amount for each coverage as shown in the Schedule of Benefits; 14. due to a Pre-Existing Condition, as defined in the Policy. If the event prevents You from reporting the cancellation, the 72-hour notice requirement does not apply; however, You must, if requested, provide proof that said event prevented him or her from reporting the cancellation within the specified period.
